


## Using the Google Sites ePortfolio template

To get started, you will need to create an account with Google or use an existing Google account. This email address will be attached to your site, make sure you use a professional email address. Google provides a suite of apps for you to create digital content, but the two main applications you will use to create your portfolio will be Google Docs and Google Sites. Google Docs allows you to create and edit documents, spreadsheets, and presentations online, and allows you to share what you create with a select group of people or with the world. Google Sites allows you to easily create a website to showcase your work and you can choose the level of access, keep it private, restrict to a group or everybody.

Open Google sites <https://sites.google.com/> you are prompted to enter your email address and password. In Sites, click the Create button and choose **in classic Sites**.



Click [Browse the gallery for more](#) to search for the SET2CLIL template that you will use to start your ePortfolio setup. In the Search box, type in SET2CLIL and click to highlight this template and click the Select button.




To edit pages, click the link of the page you want to edit, for example my profile and note the




3 buttons on the top right hand side of your site.

Click the pencil and this opens the page in Edit mode.

The Menu bar and Tool bar provides you with formatting tools. Click into the Personal Details space and insert your text. To do basic formatting use the tool bar icons. Click **Save** to store your work.




Edit the pages to add your personal reflections. The **Insert** menu allows you to insert, Image, Links, Videos, Maps and other features below.



## Image:

To insert an image, click Image and from the Add an Image dialog box choose **Upload Image** and browse to your image. Type in Alt text to describe your image for people who are using screen readers to view sites. Click OK.

## Hyperlink:

To insert a hyperlink, from the **Insert** menu, choose **Link** and select **Web Address** from the Create Link box. Type in the text you want display and the web address. If you want your page to open in a new tab, click the checkbox, Open this link in a new window. Click **OK**.



## Insert Google Docs Video



Paste the URL of your video into Google Docs.
